**RECEIVER'S NOTICE OF DECEMBER 22, 2021**  
**CLAIMS BAR DATE AND NOTICE OF PUBLICATION**

On June 16, 2021, Burton W. Wiand, the Court-appointed Receiver over the corporate Defendants and all Relief Defendants (the “Receiver” and the “Receivership” or “Receivership Estate”), filed a Motion To (1) Approve Procedure To Administer Claims And Proof Of Claim Form, (2) Establish Deadline For Filing Proof Of Claim Forms, (3) Permit Notice By Mail And

Publication, and (4) Approve the Retention of Omni Agent Solutions. (Doc. 335)

(the “Claims Motion”). The Receiver explained the need for a Claims Bar Date:

The Receiver seeks entry of an order establishing a deadline by which all claimants holding a claim against a Receivership Entity arising out of the activities of the Receivership Entities (the “Claimants”) must assert their claim (the “Claims Bar Date”). The Receiver proposes that the Claims Bar Date be set 90 days from the mailing of the Proof of Claim Form to known possible Claimants. This date will allow the Receiver sufficient time to arrange for and publish the proposed Notice and give potential Claimants sufficient time to file a claim with the Receiver. Claimants must file claims to participate in any distribution of Receivership assets. The Receiver proposes that any claim received after the Claims Bar Date be disallowed.

A Claims Bar Date is necessary to allow as many Claimants as possible to participate in the claims process while also allowing the Receiver to obtain certainty in a reasonably prompt fashion of the total amount of potential claims to the Receivership assets. Such certainty is necessary to be able to determine the amount of money each Claimant with an allowed claim is entitled to receive and to facilitate a timely claims resolution and distribution process.

Doc. 335 at 6-7 (footnote omitted). The Court granted the Claims Motion on July 8, 2021, including the request for entry of a Claims Bar Date:

Each person or entity that asserts a claim against the Receivership arising out of or related in any way to the acts, conduct, or activities of the Receivership Entities and the fraudulent investment scheme set forth in the complaint filed by the Securities and Exchange Commission in this action must submit an original Proof of Claim Form, as attached to the Motion as Exhibit 1. Proof of Claim Forms may be submitted by one of the following options: (1) online, through the Receiver’s eClaims portal which can be accessed at [www.omniagentsolutions.com/equalt](http://www.omniagentsolutions.com/equalt); (2) by uploading the completed Proof of Claim Form to [www.omniagentsolutions.com/equalt](http://www.omniagentsolutions.com/equalt); or (3) by mailing the completed Proof of Claim Form to EquiAlt Receiver Claims

Processing, c/o Omni Agent Solutions, 5955 De Soto Avenue, Suite 100, Woodland Hills, CA 91367. **Proof of Claim Forms shall be received on or before 90 days from the mailing of the Proof of Claim Form to known possible Claimants** (the “**Claims Bar Date**”). Any person or entity that fails to submit a claim to the Receiver on or before the Claims Bar Date (i.e., fails to take the necessary steps to ensure that the Proof of Claim Form is received by the Receiver on or before the Claims Bar Date), shall be forever barred and precluded from asserting any claim against any Receivership Entity or the Receivership. The Claims Bar Date will apply to all creditors and victims of the EquiAlt scheme.

Doc. 347 ¶ 2 (original emphasis).

On September 23, 2021, the Receiver mailed 3,370 claims packets to investors, potential investors, and other creditors. **As such, the Claims Bar Date is December 22, 2021.**

Any creditor or potential creditor that did not receive a claims packet can obtain a Proof of Claim Form from the Receiver’s website, [www.equialtreceivership.com](http://www.equialtreceivership.com), or Omni Agent Solutions’ website, [www.omniagentsolutions.com/equialt](http://www.omniagentsolutions.com/equialt).

Additionally, as set forth in the Claims Motion, the Receiver has published notice of the Claims Bar Date in *The USA Today* (national edition)(10/22/21), *Arizona Republic* (local edition)(10/21/21), the *Tampa Bay Times* (local edition)(10/27/21), the *San Francisco Chronicle* (local edition)(10/22/21), the *Los Angeles Times* (local edition)(10/21/21), and on the Receiver’s website. See Composite Exhibit 1.
