ORDER

Accordingly, their decisions and opinions are only delivered in response to those legal instruments filed with the Clerk's Office in accordance with governing rules of procedure. Moreover, Local Rule 3.01(j) requires that all pleadings and papers be filed with the Clerk of Court and shall not be addressed or presented to the Court in the form of a letter or the like.

Accordingly, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the correspondence will be disregarded as inappropriate and will not be considered. Should an individual or entity seek relief from the Court, they must do so via proper pleading or motion. The Court advises the Parties that they should refrain from instructing non-parties to communicate with the Court.
