

BRIAN DAVISON TO BE SENTENCED FOR TAX FRAUD

On March 13, 2025, the United States filed an Information against Brian Davison for three counts of preparation and presentation of a false and fraudulent tax return related to tax years 2017, 2018, and 2019. *U.S. v. Davison*, Case No. 8:25-cr-124-MSS-TGW (M.D. Fla.) On the following day, the government filed the plea agreement signed by Davison (represented by a federal public defender), in which he pled guilty to these charges. In this plea agreement, Davison agreed to make full restitution to the IRS for taxes due and owing for 2016 through 2019, plus interest and penalties, in the estimated amount of \$6,293,592. Acting on the Magistrate's Report and Recommendation regarding the plea, District Court Judge Mary Scriven affirmed and adopted the Magistrate's recommendation and accepted the plea on April 23, 2025. Davison's sentencing is scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on June 17, 2025.
